ICCTA BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

February 19, 2013

The ICCTA Board of Representatives took the following actions at its February 11, 2013 meeting at the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel in Washington, D.C.:

- Adopted the association's 2013 state legislative agenda;
- Approved an ICCTA-developed pension reform proposal that would increase the employee contribution for Tier 1 community college employees and shift the employer cost of community college pensions from the state of Illinois to local community college districts. This proposal – which would apply only to community colleges -- would not result in a loss of benefits for retirees or current employees and would also stabilize the College Insurance Program;
- Learned that ICCTA president Reggie Coleman (John Wood) has appointed a special ICCTA committee
 to provide ongoing input on pension reform issues. The committee is chaired by former ICCTA president
 Jim Ayers (Parkland);
- Were informed that Friday, April 19, is the deadline to submit nominations for the offices of ICCTA vice
 president, treasurer, and secretary for 2013-2014. The ICCTA Nominating Committee will interview
 interested candidates on Tuesday, April 30, in Springfield;
- Learned that ICCTA's March 8 seminars will focus on: 1) "best practices" in student success and completion, and 2) the impact of the Affordable Care Act on community colleges. Future seminars may focus on college readiness and 'cloud computing';
- Received updates on the Illinois Community College Board, the Illinois Presidents Council, the Illinois Student Assistance Commission, the ICCB Student Advisory Committee, and the Association of Community College Trustees;
- Congratulated ICCB president/CEO Geoffrey Obrzut upon his June 30 retirement;
- Learned that student leaders will lobby to preserve adult education on April 17 in Springfield;
- Were thanked by ACCT chair Jean Torgeson, chair-elect John Sanders (Logan), and president/CEO Noah Brown for Illinois' strong support and participation in ACCT's annual National Legislative Summit;
- Previewed ICCTA's February 13 meeting with U.S. Sens. Richard Durbin and Mark Kirk; and
- Endorsed Eleanor McKinney (Elgin) for the ACCT Diversity Committee.

The next ICCTA Board of Representatives meeting will take place on Saturday, March 9, at the Westin Lombard Yorktown Center in Lombard.
